- 100 credits minimum

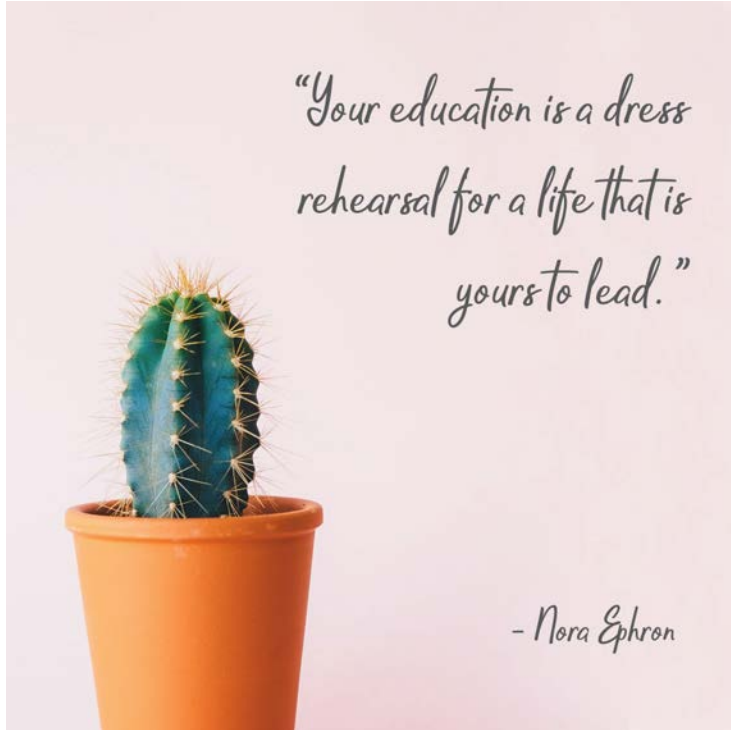

## Graduation Fee - \$80

- Cover items such as, but not inclusive to: regalia costs (caps, tassels, gown), certificate printing and covers, general supplies and needs for Student Grad Council, Grad keepsakes, composite photo, additional yearbook pages, decorations for event, etc.
