



- Deadline for ordering AP exams was November 15
 - We ordered 118 exams covering 14 courses
 - Last year there were 197 exams ordered due to the fact there was no cancellation fee
 - Only 68 of the exams were written
- Exam cost is \$140 per exam, with a \$60 cancellation fee
 - A fund has been set up for students who would not be able to afford to write the AP exams
