#### **June is Pride Month!**

**Why are there different Pride Flags? What does the Pride Flag mean?**

 The original pride flag was designed by artist Gilbert Baker for the 1978 San Francisco Pride and had 8 colours. Hot pink represents sexuality. Red represents life. Orange represented healing. Yellow represents sunlight. Green represents nature. Turquoise represents magic and art. Indigo represents serenity and harmony. Violet represents spirit.

 The Gilbert Flag was modified to the standard 6 colour one recognized today for practical reasons when it came to mass production - hot pink fabric was challenging to find. The 6 Colour Flag remains the easiest to identify symbol for Pride.

 Over time, different flags evolved as an outward symbol for different genders and sexualities. The Progress Pride Flag was designed in 2018 by Daniel Quasar, to be more inclusive to BIPOC people in the community, and clearly represents people who are transgender and gender nonconforming.
