#### June is Pride Month!

**Why June? - the Stonewall Riots took place June 28, 1969**

Early Pride celebrations were less celebration and more militant - the goal was liberation and equality for members of the LGBT communities. The evening of June 28, 1969, police raided a popular gay bar in NYC, the Stonewall Inn. While raids were common, on that evening, people fought back, rioting against police for days. Overtime, Pride has evolved to have a more celebratory tone, but members of the LGBTQ+ community remain aware of the need to defend their rights, and so recognize the original roots.

**Marsha P Johnson** - Marsha P Johnson was a trans woman today most commonly associated with the Stonewall Riots. While she was not present at the bar when the riots broke out, she became a prominent figure in the fight for gay liberation and an outspoken activist for the trans community and AIDS.

In 1992, Marsha's body was found floating in the Hudson River, her death ruled a suicide. Friends and community members maintain she was murdered for her activism, as she suffered a massive wound to the back of her head. Trans people, particularly trans women of colour, are still disproportionately victims of violent crime.

The Gay Men's Flag: As the rainbow pride flag became associated with many LGBTQ+ identities, this flag was designed to be specifically for gay men. The turquoise and blue represent community, healing and love, while the white stripe represents non-binary, trans and nonconforming folks.
