Fall Math Competitions:

Students who are interested in pursuing post secondary education in mathematics and computing science are encouraged to take part in the following competitions. Participating in a mathematics or computing contest helps students to develop invaluable skills, like creative problem-solving and big-picture thinking. These contests help students to discover and grow a love of mathematics and computer science, apply knowledge in novel situations, and make connections across topics in mathematics and computing. These contests are challenging but attainable activities for young learners, they also build students' confidence in their ability to tackle difficult problems — a key ingredient for student success both inside and outside the classroom.
