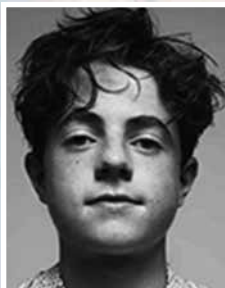


### Alex Bellisle

Mr. Boddy

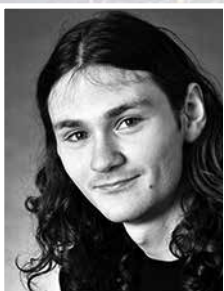

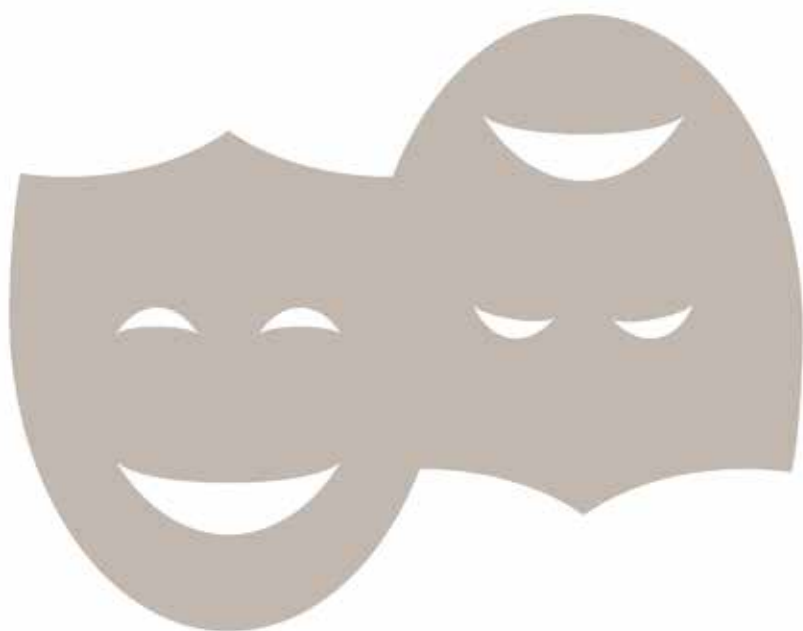
