ACADEMIC AWARDS

Christine Schmid Memorial Scholarship

Value: \$500

This scholarship will be awarded to a grade 12 student who will be pursuing post-secondary studies in the areas of **Education, Art** and/or **French**. The scholarship recipient will show:

- a) service to the community, school and fellow students.
- b) participation in community activities and extra-curricular school activities.
- c) a caring attitude towards others

Creative Music Award

Value: \$200

Awarded to a grade 12 **General Music** or **Rock & Pop** student who demonstrates outstanding:

- a) leadership and commitment.
- b) performance and technical skills.
- c) creativity.

Elk Island Public Schools ATA Local Awards

(Required: separate application, essay, and two reference letters)

Value: \$500

The Elk Island Local of the Alberta Teachers Association awards two annual scholarships of \$250 or one scholarship of \$500 to:

- a) A child of an Elk Island Teacher who has been accepted to the Faculty of Education in an accredited institution and who has demonstrated a high level of achievement. (If no applicant meets criteria proceed to #2)
- b) A child of a teacher (not employed by EIPS) who has been accepted to the Faculty of Education in an accredited institution and who has demonstrated a high level of achievement. (If no applicant meets criteria proceed to #3)
- c) A grade 12 student who has been accepted to the Faculty of Education in an accredited institution who has demonstrated a high level of achievement.

Value: \$750

Awarded to a student who consistently:

Inter Pipeline Discovery Award - (Required: separate application plus a paragraph stating financial difficulty)

Value: \$2,000

The Discovery Award program provides bursaries to grade 12 students who have financial difficulties and want to pursue a post-secondary education in an industry related field. Industry related programs include: Accounting, Business, Finance, Investor Relations, Machinist, Welder and Millwright Apprenticeships, Public/Community Relations, Automated Systems Engineering Technology, Engineering or Engineering Technology, Industrial Instrumentation Technology, Instrument Mechanic, Process Operations, Welding or Engineering Technology.

The recipient for this award is selected by Inter Pipeline Discovery Award's selection committee.

Value: \$500

EIPS AWARDS

Kevin Gaetz

Up to two students from each senior high will be awarded a monetary amount from the Edmonton Community Foundation for the Kevin Gaetz Award, which recognizes and supports students in their pursuit of post-secondary education. This award will be given to a student who:

- a) meets the entrance requirements for the program of post-secondary studies to be supported;
- b) has a financial need that would restrict the student's ability to pursue such post-secondary studies; and
- c) demonstrates perseverance and commitment to post-secondary education, which may also be described as desire and determination to pursue further learning in an area of interest.

Konica Minolta

Konica Minolta wishes to acknowledge deserving students in need of support to pursue their career, education and learning goals. Three EIPS students will be selected to each receive this \$500 award. The scholarship recognizes and supports students who have overcome some level of adversity to graduate from senior high and continue their learning in any capacity. Students who demonstrate a strong work ethic, optimism, resilience, knowledge and success in their pursuit to achieve their Alberta High School Diploma or Alberta High School Certificate of Achievement may be nominated.

WesTec

Dow Canada is recognizing two outstanding students in EIPS for their academic achievements, demonstration of innovation and pursuits in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) with a \$500 scholarship.

Criteria: Any Grade 12 student with aspirations to pursue a career in STEM with good academic standing. Successful candidates will be selected based on their 300-word abstract submission demonstrating some level of innovation, creativity and impact.

The Abstract Topic: Describe a time in your life—not limited to STEM activities—when you took an innovative approach to solving a problem that made a positive impact. The abstract should describe the problem, the challenges faced and the outcome.

Governor General Award

Eligible institutions must apply to the Chancellery of Honours to participate in the program. Once accepted into the program, participating institutions automatically receive their medals annually. The Chancellery must be advised of any change in status affecting the participant's eligibility.
